Arriving in Kuala Lumpur

International carriers flying carriers (eg. Cathay Pacific, Malaysia Airlines, KLM, Jetstar) that land at the main terminal can:

a) Take the KLIA Express train to KL Sentral

- Once you're out of the arrivals hall look for signs indicating KLIA Ekspres / Express.
- Trip takes about 30 minutes with trains leaving every 15 minutes.
- Tickets are RM35 one way and RM65 return.

b) Take a taxi to Kuala Lumpur.

- Coupons can be bought inside the Terminal building (usually cheaper than negotiating personally)
- Expect to dish out about RM70 – RM150 depending on whether it's a budget or premier / bigger cab
- The trip takes about 45 minutes to 1.5 hours depending on traffic conditions.

International carriers flying budget airlines (Air Asia, Tiger Airways) arriving at the Low Cost Carrier Terminal (LCCT) can:

a) Take a taxi to Kuala Lumpur

- Coupons can be bought inside the Terminal building (usually cheaper than negotiating)
- Expect to dish out about RM70 – RM150 depending on number of people and luggages
- When you exit customs, face the road. Turn left and keep going. The front of the taxi stand is near the far end of the terminal. Look for the blue vested attendants to assign you a taxi.
- Trip takes about 45 minutes to 1.5 hour depending on traffic conditions.

b) Take a bus to KL Sentral

- When you exit customs, face the road. Turn left and keep going. The buses are located

past the far end of the terminal.

- Fare for the buses are RM8 to RM10 and it takes about 1 to 1.5 hours to get to KL Sentral. Tickets can be bought from the guys in front of each bus.

c) Take a bus to KLIA and take the KLIA Express train to KL Sentral

- Look for the Nadi KLIA Bus; fare is RM1.50
- Once at KLIA, look for KLIA Ekspres / Express on signs
- Fare is RM35 one way, RM65 return.
- Trip takes about 30 minutes with trains leaving every 15 minutes.

Hi,

One can actually take the train to KLIA from LCCT and it's pretty cheap, only RM12.50.

You will need to purchase the ticket itself from LCCT and board the shuttle bus. The shuttle bus will take you to the Salak Tinggi station and from there, you can take the KLIA express to KL Sentral.

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
